

How the Process Worked

- Workgroup members attended and actively participated during and between the four Workgroup meetings.
- Interested parties attended or phoned in and provided input.
- DHCS/CDA posted registration information, agendas, and meeting materials prior to each meeting.
- DHCS/CDA prepared and posted meeting summaries and stakeholder input on the CBAS Stakeholder website after each meeting.

How the Process Worked (cont.)

- DHCS/CDA provided updates to the Olmstead Advisory Committee at their quarterly meetings.
- The Workgroup made recommendations for the CBAS Waiver Amendment and future CBAS initiatives.
- DHCS/CDA will continue to keep stakeholders informed about CBAS Waiver Amendment activities via the CBAS Stakeholder website.

Summary of Stakeholder/Workgroup Recommendations

- ❑ Workgroup put forward 18 main recommendations

Summary of Stakeholder/Workgroup Recommendations

- Delete obsolete provisions related to ADHC-to-CBAS transition.
- Continue access monitoring and streamline reporting requirements to CMS.
- Create new STC/SOP section clarifying plan/provider relationships.
- Retain language for fee-for-service grievances and appeals.

Summary of Stakeholder/Workgroup Recommendations

- Allow plan discretion regarding conducting of face-to-face eligibility determinations for individuals clinically appropriate.
- Allow authorization for up to 12 months as determined by plan to be clinically appropriate.
- Redesign the individual plan of care (IPC) form and revise references in waiver to reflect plan/provider collaboration on participant IPC development.
- Include references in waiver to care coordination.

Summary of Stakeholder/Workgroup Recommendations

- Correct waiver language regarding CBAS benefits.
- Allow planned growth of new CBAS centers.
- Retain unbundled services.
- Revise waiver quality assurance requirements.
- Address rate issues:
 - Allow plans to pay CBAS providers based on acuity
 - Restore rate
 - Establish new rate methodology

Summary of Stakeholder/Workgroup Recommendations

- Add statutory references to SOPs.
- Delete non-profit provider provisions.
- Give CDA authority to grant program flexibility.
- Allow payment for days of service <4 hours under defined circumstances.
- Revise SOP language regarding staffing and ADA.

Summary of Recommendations for Future Efforts


Form workgroups to:

- Redesign the IPC
- Explore issues with data capture and utilization
- Develop a quality strategy
- Address issues with the CBAS rate
- Reform ADHC statutes and regulations
- Address access and develop a plan/process for growth of new CBAS centers
- Develop strategies for enhancing plan/provider relationships
