FINANCIAL ALIGNMENT CONTRACT FA-2122 ALLOCATION METHODOLOGY

The purpose of this document is to outline the methodology used to allocate the Federal funds for the Financial Alignment (FA) Contract FA-2122.

Funding for the FA program comes from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Federal grant funds to provide one-on-one counseling support and information on health coverage options to beneficiaries who are dual eligible for Medicare and Medicaid.

Local assistance funds are allocated to the eight Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) to provide FA services in the seven Coordinated Care Initiative/Dual Demonstration Project Counties in California.

\$300,000 of local assistance funds from the 2122 FA grant are allocated as follows:

- \$150,000 of the \$300,000 local assistance funds is allocated equally to the eight AAAs.
- \$150,000 of the \$300,000 is allocated using the dual eligible beneficiary factors obtained from the Department of Health Care Services.
