- Updates to the SPR include new, revised, and removed data elements. These new data elements will give ACL a more comprehensive picture of the individuals served by Older Americans Act (OAA) programs. CHANGES

Legal Assistance

- Client information:
 - Client Unique ID (instead of last name, first name)
 - Gender
 - Sex at Birth
 - Sexual Orientation or Sexual Identity
 - Date of Birth OR Age
 - Race
 - Ethnicity
 - Zip Code OR Geographic Distribution
 - Household Status
 - Poverty Status
- Case information:
 - Case Unique ID
 - Client Unique ID
 - Case Open Date
 - Case Closed Date
 - Service Type
 - Service Level
 - Units
 - Month
 - Year
 - Hours (units recorded)

Additional Changes to the SPR

- Registered services—**Field: Race**
 - This will be a multi-select field, meaning more than one race can be entered.
 - **Multiple Race** and **Other** will no longer be available.
- **Caregivers of Older Adults** (previously called Caregivers Serving Elderly Individuals):
 - Relationships added:
 - Brother

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- Sister
- **Older Elderly Relative** (previously called Grandparents and Other Elderly Caregivers Serving Children):
 - Relationship added:
 - Parents
- Provider data collection: AAAs now need to report if the provider is a senior center.
- Provider data collection: AAAs now need to report if the provider is a focal point.
- RUCA Codes should now be used to determine Rural Designation (Urban/Rural) based on Zip Code.
 - For AAAs using GetCare² RTZ Systems will be updating this look-up to happen automatically.
 - For AAAs sending data through CARS, the specifications are not changing.
- For Registered Nutrition Services, there is a new clarification for Nutrition Risk:
 - Yes = High Nutrition risk score of 6+
 - No = High Nutrition risk score of 0-5
- Volunteers: In the SPR (not the File Upload Manager), within the staffing report, ACL has added in a category for reporting how many people are volunteering for the AAA.
- Health Promotion is now called **Health Promotion—Evidence Based**. The service is the same.
- In the SPR, many of the cross sections of the data with age and ADL/IADL counts have been removed.
