- Client information:

- Older Elderly Relative (previously called Grandparents and Other Elderly Caregivers Serving Children):

- Provider data collection: AAAs now need to report if the provider is a senior center.
- Provider data collection: AAAs now need to report if the provider is a focal point.
- RUCA Codes should now be used to determine Rural Designation (Urban/Rural) based on Zip Code.
 - For AAAs using GetCare² RTZ Systems will be updating this look-up to happen automatically.
 - For AAAs sending data through CARS, the specifications are not changing.
- For Registered Nutrition Services, there is a new clarification for Nutrition Risk:
 - Yes = High Nutrition risk score of 6+
 - No = High Nutrition risk score of 0-5
- Volunteers: In the SPR (<u>not</u> the File Upload Manager), within the staffing report, ACL has added in a category for reporting how many people are volunteering for the AAA.
- Health Promotion is now called **Health Promotion—Evidence Based**. The service is the same.
- In the SPR, many of the cross sections of the data with age and ADL/IADL counts have been removed.
