Good afternoon Program Managers,

The California Department of Aging (CDA) has received requests for guidance from a number of you about the provision of HICAP services during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Administration for Community Living (ACL) requires the provision of in-person counseling as well as phone counseling for HICAP service delivery. However, the COVID-19 pandemic has presented us all with an unprecedented situation. Today ACL advised CDA to follow public health guidance and limit exposure for high-risk individuals including the beneficiaries we serve. ACL recommends that limiting in-person visits at events and one-to-one counseling should be considered as well as utilizing other counseling modalities, such as teleconferencing, webinars and online telecommunications applications (e.g., SKYPE).

Governor Newsom, in his March 11 announcement, directed that "non-essential gatherings should be limited to no more than 250 people, while smaller events can proceed only if organizers can implement social distancing of 6 feet per person. Gatherings of individuals who are at a higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 should be limited to no more than 10 people, while also following social distancing guidelines. <u>https://www.gov.ca.gov/2020/03/11/california-public-health-experts-mass-gatherings-should-be-postponed-or-canceled-statewide-to-slow-the-spread-of-covid-19/</u>
