

What is an Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC)?



An ADRC is a network of organizations that work together to make access to services easier for older adults, individuals with disabilities, and family care providers. Often people with functional limitations need ongoing help with tasks such as dressing, preparing meals, and managing a home.

They may also require assistance to apply for benefits or to understand all the service options available to them.

How Can an ADRC Help You?

- By providing in-person or online information about a wide range of services and resources.
- By presenting options for long term services and supports so that informed choices can be made about care planning.
- By offering short-term services (up to 90-days) to address urgent needs and prevent unnecessary admission to a nursing facility or hospital.
- By coordinating relocation from hospitals or nursing facilities back to a home or the community and arranging for needed support.
